The following questions have been asked and are answered below:

Q: Are nonlethal weapons such as batons, pepper spray, and tasers allowed?

A: Yes, they are allowed, provided the guards have completed state-certified training for the devices and methods they will use. The guards must provide proof of initial training, and refresher training will need to be conducted at a minimum of every two years when using the devices at this job site. Additionally, guards who will use these devices and methods should have a current First Aid, CPR, and AED certification. If these devices and methods are used, an appropriate First Aid kit and AED must be available on-site, readily accessible, and maintained.

See rule 0780-05-02-.02 DEFINITIONS OF CHAPTER 0780-05-02 PRIVATE PROTECTIVE SERVICES and 0780-05-02-.15 AUTHORIZED WEAPONS.

Q: Will the entire facility need to be toured hourly?

A: Yes, an electronic guard tour system must be implemented to ensure and document that guards are making their required tours. Tour marker points must be installed at points the City Security & Safety Department agrees upon and are subject to change based on the scope and progress on the job site over the life of the project.

Q: Who should be contacted in case of trespassing?

A: The City Security & Safety Department should be contacted from 9 AM to 11:30 PM, Monday through Friday. For all other times and holidays, the Clarksville Police Department should be contacted.

Guards are required to wear Personal Protective Equipment, including a hard hat, steel-toe boots, a high-visibility vest, and eye and hearing protection if site conditions require it.

All vendors are required to acknowledge receipt of this addendum in their bid.
