This addendum is hereby incorporated into the Bid Documents for the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by underlining, deletions are indicated by ~~striketrough~~.

1. Q1: Is demo of existing sod (approx. 2700 SF) where the new p[lanting bed is to be constructed the City responsibility?
Q2: There are (8) existing cabbage palms, 3 are to remain per plan. Is the City responsible for the removal of the other 5 palms?
Q3: If the Landscape Contractor is responsible for the above items can you please update the bid form for these items?

A 1-3: Scope of Work item 4. "Existing plants: If the proposed plants shown on the plan interfere with existing landscaping it is to be removed in favor of the new plantings." This item include trees, bushes, grass and/or ground covers that would interfere with the installation of the landscape plan. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to prep and install as specified and designed.

Q4: Due to material expenses can we submit a schedule of fees based of the percentage of completion?

A4: You must submit the bid schedule form (page 12-13) as presented in the bid and not an alternate form created by yourself. Successful Contractor can submit progress payment requests based on the factors below.

We can pay 50% of "stored materials" upon verification of purchase (Copies of receipts or orders submitted to the City Project Manager). Stored materials would include any product that has been tagged, reserved, purchased and/ or delivered to the contractor.

Contractor may submit a fee schedule as follows:
Stored Materials- 50%

50% completion- all irrigation system components are installed as designed and confirmed properly operational.

Substantial Completion- Project is completely installed, as designed

Final Completion- Contractor will complete any punch list items and have all equipment removed from site.

2. All other terms and conditions remain the same.

The Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum on the Bid Proposal Form.
