<u>License Classification</u>

The requirement for license classification is hereby revised as follows: All bidders must be licensed contractors and must have a full HRA – Highway, Railroad and Airport Construction classification or have two subcategories of HRA-A and HRA-B or have a full MU - Municipal and Utility Construction classification.

Clarification of Contract Documents and Specifications:

The following are responses to questions received from potential bidders:

Questions

- 1) Is there a construction access point the contractor can use?

 The contractor can come up the greenway from Neyland Drive. It is the contractor's responsibility to determine the best way to access the site.
- 2) What type of containment of equipment will be required?

 There are not specific equipment containment requirements, but the contractor must follow City of Knoxville BMPs and Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Handbook. It is the contractor's responsibility to make sure the site meets those requirements.
- 3) Is the Contractor responsible for damages outside of the limits of this project? Yes the contractor is responsible for damages. Due to the constraints of the trail, we recommend the contractor utilize smaller equipment to access the site.
- 4) Are working hours limited? Sunrise to Sunset, Monday through Saturday.
