

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-084**

**A RESOLUTION REJECTING THE ONE BID RECEIVED AND  
ACCEPTING THE NEGOTIATED PRICE FOR A  
UTV FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM  
HALL'S MOTORSPORTS EASTERN SHORE  
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,089**


**FINDINGS:**

1. The bid opening for Three UTVs for the Coastal Resources and Fire Departments was scheduled for February 17, 2022.
2. One bid was received, but the Coastal Resources and Fire Departments have reviewed the submission and determined that the proposed alternate equipment does not meet bid specifications.
3. In accordance with Section 41-16-50(a) of the Code of Alabama, 1975, in the event only one bidder responds to the invitation to bid, the awarding authority may reject the bid and negotiate the purchase or contract, providing the negotiated price is lower than the bid price. The negotiated price is not less than the single bid received, but since the received bid does not meet specifications, it is determined to be nonresponsive.
4. Because no bids meeting specifications were received, the City of Orange Beach accepts the negotiated price of \$20,089 for a UTV for the Fire Department, as specified by the bid documents, submitted by Hall's Motorsports Eastern Shore.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE BEACH, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:**


1. That the City of Orange Beach hereby accepts the negotiated price for a UTV for the Fire Department, as specified by the bid documents, submitted by Hall's Motorsports Eastern Shore;
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to approve payment to Hall's Motorsports Eastern Shore in the amount of \$20,089.00 for a 2021 Honda Pioneer SXS10M5PM 1000-5 UTV; and
3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
