6.7. During the project, a National Association of Corrosion Engineers (N.A.C.E.) Certification number must be provided prior to execution of the contract.

REVISION TO BIDDER LICENSES

This Addendum provides a revised Section 5, Page CF-2 form and must be used in place of the original form when submitting your bid.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following are answers to all questions received to date. Information shall be considered by proposers when preparing their responses.

- Q1. We are interested in bidding the above referenced project. However, we do not carry a National Association of Corrosion Engineers (N.A.C.E.) Certification number in accordance with specifications 6.7. To our knowledge the State of FL nor the AWWA requires this certification. It is possible that many of the interested vendors do not carry this certification. Is it possible to remove this requirement from the specifications?
- A1. This Addendum has revised the language to not require NACE certification.

All other elements of the Solicitation Document remain unchanged.
