Addendum Number 1 is issued to provide changes and/or clarifications to the above referenced RFP as per the following:

Question: What is the anticipated "go-live" start date?

Answer: Once the award is approved by the commission

Question: Would an extension be considered for the submission of this RFP?

Answer: No

Question: Is an electronic submission via email acceptable?

Answer: Per RFP, Offerors shall submit proposals in one (1) original and five (5) copies,

and one (1) electronic copy.

Question: Term of the contract?

Answer: One year with possible extensions

Question: Minimum product Warranty?

Answer: Per manufacturer

Question: What budget has been allocated for this project?

Answer: This is a task order agreement so the budget will depend on each department requesting the task order.

Camera surveillance systems (Indoor and Outdoor)

Question: Qty (How many Indoor)?

Answer: Depends on the task order and each departments needs

Question: Qty (How many Outdoor)?

Answer: Depends on the task order and each departments needs

Question: Can you share a map/floorplan of the building with where the cameras will be mounted?

Answer: No, as it will be in between the department and the contractor to discuss design

Question: Requirement for Camera onboard retention (Days of standard retention)/onboard storage (256GB - 2TB)?

Answer: Depends on the task order and each departments needs

Question: Low Voltage Cabling requirement (CAT5/CAT6)?

Answer: Some cabling is possible

Building Security Alarm Systems

Question: How many buildings with a physical address will you be covering with professional video monitoring (Alarm License)?

Answer: Depends on the task order and each departments needs

Question: What is the sq footage of the building?

Answer: Depends on the which departments request alarm systems

Question: What Intrusion Detection Devices/Sensors will you be needing and how many (ie Motion Sensor, Door Contact Sensor, Glass Break Sensor, Panic Button Sensor, Water Leak Sensor)?

Answer: Depends on the task order and each departments needs

Security door applications. Both key fob and card reader.

Question: Qty (How many doors)?

Answer: Depends on the task order and each departments needs

Question: Any Gates (how many)?

Answer: Depends on the task order and each departments needs

Question: Can you share a map/floorplan of the building with where the door access control will be?

Answer: No, as it will be in between the department and the contractor to discuss design

Question: What access control infrastructure is currently in place?

Answer: Each building is different. The police department has an RFID fob system while City Hall has a proximity card system. Others do not have a system.

Question: Are all of the crash bars, locks, maglocks, and strikes on the doors operational and in good working condition?

Answer: Yes

Question: REX button operational at each door?

Answer: No

Question: Door frames are metal and hollow to allow for wiring to be run throughout?

Answer: Depends on the building

Question: Space available within the IDF/MDF Closets?

Answer: Depends on the building

Installation of all security devices. Including panels, control boxes, motion detectors, cabling and any other necessary items.

Question: Low Voltage Cabling requirement (CAT5/CAT6)?

Answer: Depends on the task order and each departments needs

Question: Certification?

Answer: Depending on the work, certifications may be required

Question: Availability (time of day/days of the week) to allow for work to be done?

Answer: Departments would provide the hours the building would be available

Maintenance and integration of current systems with new systems

Question: What are the details within the maintenance contract?

Answer: Depends on the task order and each departments needs

Question: Can you provide the specifications within the requested integration of the current systems?

Answer: If you are asked to integrate with an existing system, you would be provided with the available information for that system.

Question: Integration with existing camera surveillance systems?

Answer: Possibly

Question: Integration with existing access control systems?

Answer: Possibly

Question: Would there be a possibility for scheduling a site visit for this RFP?

Answer: Not at this time.

Question: Is there potential for this RFP to be awarded to multiple firms?

Answer: No

Question: Is there any information available for the existing systems such as manufacturer, models or age of systems?

Answer: No
