### **Addendum #1 and Clarification DUI Court SCRAM Ankle Bracelets Bid Date September 9, 2021**

**Clarification-** As noted in the cover letter dated August 17, 2021, “We will accept all bids with exceptions noted, and all bids will be given equal consideration”.

**Williamson County has received the following questions:**

- 1) Can you tell me the number of clients in DUI Court on an alcohol device at the end of July 31, 2021? *9 participants*
- 2) Can you tell me the average number of clients in DUI Court on alcohol monitoring each month for the fiscal year of 20/21? *For the grant fiscal year of 20/21, there have been 27 participants. All participants wear the monitoring device for an undetermined amount of time after they enter the program. Per month, our average number of participants coming into the program is 2.25, but that does not reflect each month, it is an average based on all the numbers for each month. On average, we will have around 9-12 people on devices each month.*
- 3) Does the County intend to pay for any of the costs for the alcohol bracelets? *The county does not pay for anything. This is funded through a federal grant. The participants are responsible for all costs associated with the monitoring device, including installation and daily monitoring fees. Frequently, the person already has a monitoring device when they are pleaing in, so they could either be already indigent and on state funded financial assistance. If someone reports they are having trouble paying, they are given an affidavit of indigence to determine if they qualify and if the grant has the funds, it is covered.*
- 4) If yes, what part of the expenses is the County willing to pay? Daily rate? Lost equipment? Etc. *Again, the county does not pay for anything. The grant currently pays \$8.00 a day and \$50.00 install fee if the participant cannot pay. Lost equipment would be at the cost of the participant and not the county.*
- 5) If yes, what is the annual budget amount for paying for alcohol monitoring? *The annual grant budget is \$12,500.*
- 6) If yes, how many of the active cases are county paid? and how many of the cases are offender paid? *As of 8/31/2021, there are nine total participants on the device. Out of those nine, the grant is paying for three of those devices. The other six are either paying out of pocket or were already on state funded financial assistance prior to entering the program.*

7) If yes, what is the rate the County pays per day for alcohol monitoring? ***The rate the grant currently pays per day is \$8.00***

8) What is the rate the offender pays per day for alcohol monitoring if offender paid? ***The rate the offender pays is \$10.00***

9) Is there just one copy of the bid proposal to be submitted? ***Yes***

10) Are the six forms at the end of the bid to be submitted with the bid or are included only for example and to be signed only by the winning bidder? ***Per cover letter, affidavits are to be submitted in sealed envelope with bid.***

11) Does Williamson County give additional consideration to minority, veteran, woman, or small businesses so they can compete with large corporations when bidding on government work? ***No***
