 - Tab 8 References All firms may submit <u>one</u> Reference Form listing projects for Indian River County (if multiple POCs, list contact names, but you may exclude contact phone and email). Firms may submit one Reference Form with "Confidential Client(s)" listed. At least one reference must provide current contact information to facilitate verification (therefore, if Indian River County is your only named reference, name <u>one</u> contact person, phone, and email).
