ADDENDUM #1

Re: Proposal #15-1020A City Hall Roof Replacement

This addendum supersedes and supplements all portions of the proposal documents and becomes part of the Contract Documents for the above referenced project. Failure to acknowledge this addendum in the Proposal Form may result in the Proposal being deemed nonresponsive. Where any original item is amended, voided or superseded hereby, the provision of such item not so specifically amended, voided or superseded shall remain in effect.

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1. The correct opening date and time is April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at 3:30pm instead of August 8, 2015. The proposal opening is done privately without the Proposing Contractors by the evaluating committee.
2. The Proposing Contractor must have the General contractor's, and if applicable the subcontractor(s), name (as stated on license), license number, expiration date, classification (at least BC/BC-B), and monetary limit (at least total cost of project) on the outside of the sealed proposal envelope when the proposal is submitted. **T.C.A. 62-6-119**
3. The Proposing Contractor must adhere to all state laws requiring the contractor, and subcontractor, to be licensed with the State. A copy of the license(s) must be submitted with the proposal. **T.C.A. 62-6-111**
4. The Proposing Contractor must have a warranty on the roof replacement in writing for at least 15 years or more. Length and details of the warranty will be included in the evaluation criteria.
5. To adhere to State law, the Proposing Contractor must have their plans and proposal looked at, and approved, by an engineer to make sure the project is proposed correctly and feasibly. The approval statement must be on the Engineer firm's letterhead and notarized.
6. The Proposing Contractor agrees to meet all State laws that may pertain to the Contractor when creating and turning in the proposal.

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
