- 1. Do you want safety protection around skylights? Yes
- 2. Can we bid a line item in reference to the aluminum coating on existing roof outside the main lobby entrance? Yes
- 3. Is the new construction area also getting the liquid roof coating? No that is not part of the liquid roofing bid.
- 4. Do we need to cut off roof vents below the roof? No they are already disconnected and can be pulled out.
- 5. Does this bid require a performance bond? Yes 5% of total cost of the project.
- 6. Is this project tax exempt? Yes the awarded vendor with be supplied with a 5060 form.
- Has there been any guidance on what manufacturers are approved for this coating application? No
- 8. What is the approximate timeline for this project? For ARPA purposes the timeline is as follows: End of 2024 project must be awarded, end of 2026 project must be completed.
  - The County requirement is:the project/work needs to begin within 30 days from the award date of this project. (See addendum #2)
- 9. Will the Curbs and pipes to be removed be marked by FCSO before project begins? Yes
- 10. Will core sampling be allowed during PRE-BID? Not unless it is approved and set up with the Maint. Director of the Franklin County Sheriff's Office, Bill Barnes. (See addendum #2)
- 11. Could you please provide the specific manufacturer or product that you're referencing for the roof coating project? We have looked at Tremco, but it isn't the only manufacturer we would use.
- 12. What kind of walkways are required? Walkways to be installed to and around serviceable equipment. Install walkways with fluid applied top-coat. (ensure walkways are masked off to ensure uniform appearance). Broadcast granules into topcoat at walkways to ensure slip resistance walking surface.
- 13. What to do with the perimeter termination bar? Bring scrim to bar, coat over termination bar with appropriate topcoat sealant.
