Addendum 01 November 22, 2022 RFP 23-R0013 Fire Alarm Monitoring System

The purpose of this Addendum 01 to RFP 23-R0013 for Fire Alarm Monitoring System, dated November 22, 2022, is to list the key points of discussion from the mandatory pre-proposal conference.

- The time frame for the City to award contract is January 1, 2023. Contractor will be expected to start work as soon as project is fully awarded.
- The Department of Corrections states that there are no permits required. Contractor will be responsible for all other licenses and fees, including a City business license.
- Any contractor who desires a visit to inspect the work area prior to submitting a bid may
 visit the sites, however the Law Enforcement sites will require an escort. Contractors are
 advised to make themselves known to the front desk of each building upon arrival so that
 City staff is aware of your purpose in the building. Please be mindful of programs and
 activities that may be occurring at the time of your visit.
- Currently all monitoring and dispatch is handled by the Law Enforcement Dispatch Center. The City would like a system disconnected from the Law Enforcement Center and handled by a third party.
- The current antiquated system uses phone lines and the City would like to update to a system using the current industry standard, including a backup system. The existing receiver is a model Silent Knight 9800 that is located in the Law Enforcement Center.
- The existing system only sends Trouble and Alarm notifications.
- Panels include Simplex and other models.

- Additional questions are due no later than 12:00 noon on Wednesday, November 30, 2022. Questions may be submitted via e-mail to dbernstein@cityofmyrtlebeach.com All questions received by the deadline will be answered via addendum.
