## Addendum 01 August 25, 2022

## IFB 23-B0007 Ocean Boulevard ADA Compliant Ramps FY 22-23

The purpose of this Addendum 01 to IFB 23-B0007 for Ocean Boulevard ADA Compliant Ramps FY 22-23, dated August, 2022, is to list the key points of discussion from the mandatory pre-bid meeting.

- Ramps will be built one side at a time (ex: east side of road, then west side of road.) This will allow for continued access for persons with mobility impairments. To accommodate concrete quantities, two intersections can be worked on at the same time (ex: two intersections of east side only, and then the west side of the same two intersections.)
- Fiber mesh must be mixed into load at the plant. No mixing will be done on site.
- Contractor will be responsible to repair any irrigation damage caused by demolition of existing concrete.
- All ramps will be built to ADA standards. Brick pavers will be used; no plastic mats.
- Rate of demolition will be contingent upon what Contractor can rebuild the next day. This is to avoid safety hazards.
- Specific budget information is not available at this time, but the target goal is thirty (30) ramps.
- The start date can be flexible to coincide with the off-season, but work should be done by early March, 2023. Likewise, the 45-day performance period can be extended as long as the Contractor keeps in contact with the City project manager, or if additional ramps are requested by the City.
- Bike lanes and/or median strips can be used to maintain traffic flow.
- Additional questions are due no later than close of business on Thursday, September 1, 2022. Questions may be submitted via e-mail to <u>asowers@cityofmyrtlebeach.com</u> All questions received by the deadline will be answered via addendum no later than Thursday, September 8, 2022.
- Sealed bids are due in the Purchasing Office no later than 2:30PM (local time) on Thursday, September 15, 2022. No electronic submissions will be accepted. The City of Myrtle Beach is not responsible for late or misdirected mail.
