#### 2. PROJECT SUMMARY

Sewer cleaning, televising, and cured-in-place pipelining of 12,510 linear feet of existing sanitary pipes by the Inversion and Curing of a Resin-Impregnated Tube process. The project includes approximately 2,857 feet of 8" diameter, 894 feet of 10" diameter, 1,527 feet of 12" diameter, 2,007 feet of 21" diameter, 4,566 feet of 24" diameter and 659 feet of 30" diameter sanitary sewer. Work will also include bypass pumping, restoration, and other related and incidental work.

- a. Emergency vehicle access (Police & Fire) has to be maintained at all times, no exceptions. Complete closure of streets is not allowed. Keep at least one lane open during construction.
- b. Minimize any conflict with existing utilities call JULIE 48 hours before digging.
- c. In case of any gas line damage, 911 must be called and the construction activities are to stop.

## 7. STANDARD ITEMS

- a. Minimize inconvenience to residents and businesses. Dust shall be controlled and kept to a minimum. Cleanliness of the work area shall be per plans (daily cleaning).
- b. All excavated material spoils shall be removed the same day. Closure of the dump site cannot be used as an excuse. Excavation activities shall be scheduled accordingly.
- c. Any damaged street light conduits shall be replaced entirely between nearest posts (no spot repair will be permitted).
- d. Before the start of construction, the Contractor is required to video tape all streets and properties associated with the project to provide documentation on the existing conditions, with emphasis on the existing driveways and aprons. Two (2) copies of this video must be provided to the Village prior to the start of construction.
- e. The contractor is responsible for any parkway damage due to construction activities.
- f. Water will be available at no charge at the Public Works Facility located at 77 W. Hintz Road only provided that an account is set up with Finance Department. An RPZ is also available with a \$2,500 deposit.

#### 9. CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS

- **Q-1** Are videos of the sewers available?
- A-1 Yes. - **Q-2** Is there any flexibility in the completion dates?
- **A-2** The completion date for Buffalo Grove has been modified per **Addendum 1**. The work on both contracts needs to be completed in 2019.
- **Q-3** Please clarify if minimum liner thickness is starting thickness.
- **A-3** The liner thickness has been clarified per **Addendum 2**. The design parameters addressing minimum liner thickness now read:

For pipes up to and including 15" diameter:

• Minimum fully cured liner thickness: 6.0 millimeters +/- 10%

For pipes over 15" diameter:

- Minimum fully cured liner thickness: 10.0 millimeters +/- 10%
- **Q-4** For service lateral dye testing, is there a limit on the time for attempting to gain access? Access to private residences can be challenging.
- **A-4 Buffalo Grove:** VBG will assist with accessing the home between 7am and 3pm M-F. VBG will attempt to work with the contractor and homeowner to schedule the dye testing, however if after 48 hours no contact can be made with the homeowner the contractor will have to launch the laterals to confirm the functionality of the service.

**Wheeling:** Wheeling will assist with accessing the property between 7am and 3pm M-F. VWH will attempt to work with the contractor and owner to schedule the dye testing, however if after 48 hours no contact can be made with the homeowner the contractor will have to launch the laterals to confirm the functionality of the service.

- **Q-5** Is the water meter usable in both municipalities?
- A-5 No. Each municipality has different meter requirements detailed in Appendix A.
- **Q-6** Will the owner make sure that the lines that are being bypassed into will be clean, or does contractor need to do that?
- A-6 Neither Buffalo Grove nor Wheeling will be cleaning the receiving sanitary sewers. The contractor will need to do that. VBG will not be cleaning the storm structure that can be used for their bypass layout. NOTE: VBG does not want the contractor to bypass into the 8" sanitary sewer. The bypass should be looped back around to the 21".
- **Q-7** Is there a way to extend the bid date? Is it possible to delay the time to later in the day?
- **A-7** Yes. Bid opening date and time has been changed to 11 am on July 2, 2019 per **Addendum 1**.

- **Q-8** Can Buffalo Grove completion time be extended?
- **A-8** Yes. Completion time was extended to 45 days, per **Addendum 1**.
- **Q-9** Are there date constraints on use of the BGHS ball field for bypassing?
- A-9 No.
- **Q-10** Is there a place for equipment storage/material laydown yard?
- **A-10** Wheeling: The Village is open to allowing equipment to be stored at Public Works. Contractors may use 175 Old McHenry Rd. near Village water tower for material and equipment storage. Note that Village is not responsible for damage or loss of materials or equipment. The location is not secured.

**Buffalo Grove:** Depending on the specific time of construction the Village likely can supply equipment and material storage at either 801 McHenry Rd or 905 Dundee Rd. Both properties are owned by the Park District and have been available for this use before, but ultimately their events and use take priority.

- **Q-11** Can contractors work outside of the 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. time window, or the 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. time window?
- **A-11** Both Wheeling and Buffalo Grove are open to allowing work outside of the designated time window once a schedule and plan has been submitted. RJN will work with IDOT and CCDOT to allow flexibility with their time constraints.
