Bids are opened and read aloud to the public at the Robertson County Finance Office, 523 S. Brown Street, Springfield, TN 37172 immediately after the bid receipt deadline. Each vendor may submit more than one bid provided each bid meets the stated specifications. Each bid must be submitted in a separate sealed envelope with the appropriate notation on the outside. All bids must be signed by an authorized agent and submitted on the prescribed forms. Submission of bids by telegraph, telephone, or other electronic means is strictly prohibited. Any brand name called for the bid specifications is provided as a reference only. Alternate brand name items offered for bid must be equivalent as to function, basic design, type and quality of material, method of construction, and any required dimensions. Bidder must attach a letter of exception to specifications.

This addendum becomes a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original specifications as noted.

## **Changes to the Contract Documents & Specifications:**

## Item #1

Issue: Visible rock on site and contract requirements.

Response: The owner is revising the contract and bidding requirements to separate any requirements for rock associated with hammer removal. Any rock that is encountered during the project as required in the plans shall be removed first utilizing an unclassified excavation approach. The intent of this approach is to remove any large bolders with standard excavating equipment expected on this project. Should rock be encountered that is not reasonably removable via excavation, rock hammers may be utilized as approved by the engineer. An additional line item has been added to the project bid documents with a potential, estimated quantity included. This quantity may be increased, decreased or completely removed as determined by the engineer during construction.

<u>Revised Bid Proposal:</u> Bid form with itemized rock excavation line, see attached Bid Form, Page B-2 & B-3 to replace the previous Bid Form pages, insert new version with bid submittal.

#### Item #2

Issue: Roll up door dimension

<u>Response:</u> The owner desires the roll up doors on the kennel facility to be 8' wide by 7' tall as shown in plans.

Revised Bid Proposal: None.

#### Item #3

Issue: Bioretention landscaping.

<u>Response:</u> A note referencing the landscape plan exists on the stormwater bioretention areas. There is no requirement for landscape plantings, disregard the reference. The project does require the bioretention areas to be constructed, with approved bioretention soils, in accordance with stormwater requirements

shown in plans.

Revised Bid Proposal: None other than this addendum.

## Item #4

Issue: Concrete finish.

<u>Response:</u> Trowel finish is defined with the concrete specification. The seal coat called in plans shall be polyurethane based concrete sealer and contractor shall follow the manufacturer's recommendations for installation.

Revised Bid Proposal: None other than this addendum.

## Item #5

Issue: Roof decking at 5/8" vs. 1/2".

Response: The IBC code listed in plans drives the uplift specification for the roofing requirements. The ½" plywood called in plans shall be the minimum allowed. Each roofing system manufacturer may have varying installation requirements defined in order to meet the required code and those roofing system options are those of the bidding contractors.

Revised Bid Proposal: None other than this addendum clarification.

## Item #6

Issue: The clothes washer, shower, and sinks all say by owner or selected by owner. Will these items be furnished by owner and contractor installed or furnished and installed by owner?

<u>Response</u>: All units shown in mechanical plans without a specified unit type shall be selected by the owner during construction and installed by the contractor. Contractor may provide an allowance within the bid submittal for such items to limit responsibility.

Revised Bid Proposal: None other than this addendum.
