Question 1:

For the Transmittal Letter, can the document be signed using an electronic signature via docusign?

Answer 1:

Yes, the original document being submitted may have an electronic signature that must have the verification information for authenticity.

Question 2:

There are two RFPs being submitted by separate banks using the same card vendor. Is this allowed?

Answer 2:

Yes, the bank entities are separate and submitting their own RFP. The card vendor duplicate is permissible.

Question 3:

Is it correct that there should be no bindings on the original and two copies?

Answer 3:

Correct, no bindings. We will be scanning and copying the documents. They may be separated by a folder, but nothing that binds the pages together.

Question 4:

How many cards will you activate?

Answer 4:

The general information is in the packet. Initially, we will implement for summer temps, but it may grow.

Question 5:

How long is the temporary summer program?

Answer 5:

The summer programs will run through September but some programs run year round.

Question 6:

How long will the cards be in use?

Answer 6:

The cards will be kept by the employees for the returning seasons.

Question 7:

Can you send me your questions in Excel so we can respond to the RFP?

Answer 7:

The summer season has already started and will be over by the time of implementation, do you still want to have a RFP?

Answer 8:
