This addendum is hereby incorporated into the Bid Documents for the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by <u>underlining</u>, deletions are indicated by <u>strikethrough</u>.

- 1. Answers to Bidders' written questions:
  - Q1: Are all contractors permitted to bid this project, or only marine contractors?
  - A1: Contractor's shall provide a minimum of 3 similar projects within the last (5) years. Contractor's shall provide a General Contractor's license.
  - Q2: Will there be utility drawings?
  - A2: No utility work is required for this project. Locates must be performed prior to start of construction.
  - Q3: Is work permissible from land, or only from a barge?
  - A3: Work may be performed from land or barge. Contractor's are cautioned not to operate heavy equipment on the existing boat ramp or any other areas within and adjacent to project limits that are not designed for this loading.
  - Q4: Is there a designated lay down area, or area to be closed?
  - A4: The laydown area is within the parking lot and in close proximity to the project area. The exact location will be provided at the pre-construction meeting.
  - Q5: Are there jet ports in the existing piling?
  - A5: This information is not known, Contractor to confirm.
  - Q6: Is there an approved equivalent for floaters and gangways?
  - A6: There are no pre-approved equals but shop drawings meeting design criteria from alternate manufacturer's may be submitted for review.
- All other terms and conditions remain the same.
