### Question 1)

Page 3 of the RFP states "three to four people will review reports and data." Can the City of Chattanooga provide a sample of reports required, or an example of the data needed?

Answer 1) Number of times each center is visited (Ex: center 1 received 200 visitor last month); Names and address of visitors; Driver licenses number

#### Question 2)

Our proposal will require a resident be issued a "Recycling Center Residential ID" be issued from a pc or laptop on a resident's first visit. Tracking is than accomplished by using an app on a mobile device. Would this be acceptable?

## Question3)

Can the City of Chattanooga give specific detail regarding allowances / restrictions on resident visits to recycling locations other than residency? The Household Hazardous Waste facility is separate and should be customizable to receive both residents that live within the city limits as well as those that live outside the city limits in Hamilton County (East Ridge, Red Bank, etc)
