QUESTIONS

- 1. Does the County know what the specified product is?
 - a. No, as long as it is similar in style and color to the existing training room floor, it is acceptable.
- 2. Scope of Work CLARIFICATION- Rubber cove base **NOT** vinyl cove base.
- 3. Are background checks required for the crew to come in to do the work?
 - a. No, an officer will be on site. The selected vendor should comply with all drug free and e-verify policies.
- 4. Is there a loading dock and a place to store the product for acclimation?
 - a. There is no loading dock but there is a storage area for unloading and storing the product.
- 5. Will inmate labor be used to unload the product from the trucks? Or does a team need to be present to do the unloading?
 - a. Inmate labor can be used for this.
- 6. PREFERENCE- The administrative offices operate more heavily during regular business hours, Monday through Friday 8AM- 5PM so the preference would be for as much work as possible to be completed between Friday at 5PM to Monday morning at 8AM.
- 7. Is there a desired mil thickness of the protection layer on the product?



- a. 30 mil is the desired thickness of the protection layer.
- 8. Is there a local vendor preference policy?
 - a. Yes, if a local vendor is within 5% of the low bid, they will be given the opportunity to reduce their bid.
- 9. Does Lumpkin County use consortia for purchasing?
 - a. Yes.
- 10. Is there a floor plan available?
 - a. There is an evacuation plan available to show locations and number of offices.
