- 1. Question 1: In general, the RFP appears to be soliciting OH and UG <u>distribution</u> crew services. However, Section 5.2 in the Pricing is requesting rates for Misc <u>Transmission</u>

 Maintenance Equipment. Please confirm if the City requires the contracted vendor to supply these items for the contract. We are not interested in pricing under 5.2 related to transmission. This was an error on our end. This addendum removes Section 5.2 and it will be omitted. This can either be left blank or if pricing is submitted it will not be considered.
- 2. Question 2: The equipment listed under the Basic Standard Underground Crew in Section 5.3 does not include an excavator/backhoe please confirm if that is correct. We will need pricing under 5.3 on a backhoe or mini ex to the underground pricing. Please provide this addendum with pricing for the below with bid submission.

- 3. Question 3: Does the City have any minimum size requirements for the Dump Truck listed under the Basic Small Underground Crew in Section 5.4? Pricing for dump truck from section 5.4 from the pricing requirements will be exempt and not considered. This addendum removes from section 5.4 1-Dump Truck flat bed with tools from required pricing. If pricing is submitted it will be omitted.

If so, will there be a lot of transmission work? * Transmission - All equipment must be capable of accommodating wire sizes up to 1272 MCM. Any insulated equipment must be rated for 115 KV. This addendum addresses the entire section of 5.2 (Miscellaneous Transmission Maintenance Equipment) and it will be omitted and not considered.
