- What are the liquidated damages?
   There will be no liquidated damages on this project.
- What is the retention amount?
   The retention amount is 10%.
   Retention will be released as final payment.
- Where can I find the Bid Bond Form?Please see attached form.
- Can contractor remove shrubbery that is located closest to building? Yes.
- 5. Which trees will remain on the site and must be protected during demolition?
  - The trees in question will be taken care of by the City, prior to demolition.
- 6. There is a drive through area on one side of the building. Will this drive way remain intact or will the contractor remove this driveway?

  Reference Item #13 in the Scope of Work in our RFP.
- 7. Will all portions of sidewalks remain on the property? If not, which portions are slated for demolition?
  - Reference the last paragraph on page 4 in our RFP.

- 8. Can concrete slab and footers be crushed down and left as fill?
  No.
- 9. On page 13 of the asbestos report please clarify F2 (01-03) if that area contains asbestos. This area is not outlined in red. F2 (01-03) is outlined in red, however since there was not enough room, the title is beside the outlined area.
- 10. Will entire building be demo or interior of the said building to be demo? Entire building will be demolished.
- 11. If it is interior demo, is it the entire interior of the building or certain rooms in said building?
