RE: Addendum 3, RFQ No. 1706-24 "Oconee Veterans Park Expansion Project"

Pursuant to the Legal Advertisement for Request for Qualifications, RFQ No. 1706-25 for Oconee Veterans Park Expansion Project advertised on June 29, 2017, the following addendum is hereto made:

1. **QUESTION:** On page 7, paragraph A 7 requires "*Complete the Certification Form (Exhibit "A" enclosed with RFQ), and provide a scanned notarized copy with response as section "AT" of the firm's Statement of Qualifications.*" What documents should be submitted?

ANSWER: This requirement is struck in its entirety. **However, the "Contractor Affidavit under O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91(b)(1)" (Exhibit A) will be required upon the initial submittal.**

2. **QUESTION:** On page 5, paragraph A 9 requires "*Disclosure Statement" (Exhibit "C") with response as Section "A 9" of the firm's Statement of Qualifications.*" What documents should be submitted?

ANSWER: This requirement is struck in its entirety. **However, the "Schedule of Values" (Exhibit C) will be required upon the initial submittal.**

3. **QUESTION:** Will the "Subcontractor Affidavit under O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91(b)(3)" (Exhibit "H") be required at initial submittal?

ANSWER: The "Subcontractor Affidavit under O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91(b)(3)" (Exhibit "H") will not be required upon initial submittal. However, this exhibit will be required upon the GC/GM's selection of subcontractors.

In addition to the above responses, the contractor should also be aware of the following items that have been made available for the submitter's reference.

4. **Geotechnical Report:** An "Air Percussion Drilling Exploration Summary" for Veterans Park

prepared by Geo-Hydro Engineers, Inc has been posted to the Oconee County Procurement website and is provided for the submitter's convenience.

Questions and Answers are hereby added to and become a part of RFQ No. 1706-24. This Addendum modifies and forms a part of the Bid/Proposal Documents. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
