The following are items that were discussed:

1. There will not be a meeting with the State inspector with any vendors on March 21, 2017.
2. Bidders are to include a price for rental scales as a separate line item. The need for rental scales will be determined based on the time frame for the installation of the new scales.
3. The bidders should in their proposal a method to minimize concrete work.
4. A flushing system is requested. The owner will flush the scales with 40-50 pounds of water pressure or possibly use a fire truck.
5. Bidder is to include cost for a truck management scale software system. Software system is to be user friendly.
6. The owner will dispose of existing scales.
7. The deck is to be replaced.
8. The scale plates are to be bolted for easy removal.
9. There is to be an intercom and camera system provided. The camera system is to be installed at dump truck height for load inspection. The speaker is to be able to talk to truck driver.
10. The 10-year warranty is required.
11. If the project is over \$50,000, a Roane County business license is required.
12. Be sure all bid forms are completed in their entirety and submitted with your bid.
