### Williamson County Sheriff Emergency Equipment and Install-Vehicles Bid Opening March 28, 2024, 2:00 p.m.

Williamson County has received the following questions:

**Q:** Does the SO plan on ordering primarily any one kind of vehicle? The bid mentions the SO will order various models as they are available, but there are obvious cost differences between certain vehicle equipment. For example, generally metal goods for a Tahoe are more expensive than metal goods for a PIU due to the difference in size.

**A:** *In our current fleet we have Tahoe, Durango, Explorer, Chevy Silverado, Dodge Ram Trucks, Ford F-150, Traverse, Nissan Pathfinder, Chevy Equinox, Jeep Grand Cherokee, GMC Sierra, and the list goes on. There is no way to specify what vehicle we will order. It is the Sheriff's preference as well as manufacturer availability. I do know that the 23-24 Fleet will be Ford Explorer PIU's. We do however order pursuit vehicles from other manufacturers, dependent upon the needs of the mission it is to do.*

**Q:** Does the SO have a preference on lighting colors for different areas of the vehicle? What color lighting do they want on the front, side, and rear of the vehicle? Single, Dual, Trio color lighting are different price points, so this will help us be more accurate on cost.

**A:** *Light color is usually dual, blue/white. The light bar rear and light stick in are triple with blue/white/amber, with directional. Lighting color should not be an upcharge only for single, dual, or triple, pricing as far as color has never been an issue.*

**Q:** Is the SO currently using any kind of "smart siren" Such as a Whelen CenCom Core, Fed Sig Pathfinder, SoundOff 500 series, etc...?

**A:** *We currently run Fed/Sig pathfinder for our smart siren control, but are not brand specific. This controller is both in console as well as hand held.*
