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TERMINATION CLAUSES

The City reserves the right to terminate any part of or the entirety of any contract that may result from this proposal, ~~without cause~~ with just and reasonable cause and at any time with ~~thirty~~ 120 calendar day's written notice. In such case, the successful bidder shall be paid for services rendered through the date of the termination notice, and the results of all such work through that date shall become the property of the City.

There was a request for the number of applications for exemption of fees for pick-up based on income sources of a resident. The City does not have access to this information. These applications are processed through the Morgan County Health Department. The City only receives the number of approved exemptions for billing purposes.

There was a request for a breakdown of the number of green and grey carts at residences that have multiple carts. Details on the number of green and grey carts at residences with multiple carts are not available. The only details on multiple cart customers are the following:

As of Decatur Utilities (DU) latest billing report (June 2015):

Active Accounts Billed Extra Carts per DU June 2015 report: 1508

NOTE: Some of these are exempt (about 10) and some have more than one extra cart (roughly 45)

Inactive Accounts Set up to Bill Extra Carts: 82
