Specification Changes/Corrections:

Please update page 38, Section 5.4 Fee Proposal by adding the bold words and removing those stricken:

a) Schedule of Compensation

The Proposer shall complete the "Fee Proposal" included as Attachment A with the RFP. Proposers shall list hourly labor premiums rates to be used in pricing the work required by City of Parkland described in the Scope of Services. These labor rates are to be quoted on a fully-burdened basis, incorporating direct labor costs, indirect cost, and profit.

Please update page 21, Section 5.1 PURPOSE by removing just the following sentence from paragraph one:

5.1 PURPOSE:

The City's property insurance program is structured around a \$10 million loss limit.

1. Please provide the payroll by class codes.

3. Is the City looking for responses / quotes regarding the ancillary coverages (flood, student accident and storage tank)?

Please use the attached updated Fee Schedule which now includes pricing for "Ancillary Services" to include in the quote.

4. Please elaborate on what is being stated on page 21 in Section 5.1 Purpose where it states "The City's property insurance program is structured around a \$10 million loss limit". Is the \$10 million figure a typo as there is nothing in the City's current coverage that would have that exact amount. Please confirm / clarify.

Please remove the sentence from Section 5.1, paragraph 1 as shown above.

5. On page 38 section 5.4 Fee Proposal, it states to list hourly labor rates to be used in pricing the work required by the City of Parkland. Are we to include labor rates in addition to the coverage premiums on Attachment "A" or should section 5.4 have asked for the "premiums" to be listed in lieu of "labor rates"?

Yes. Section 5.4 should read "Premiums". Please see the updated section above.

6. Regarding the Background Check Affidavit form (pages 65 - 67), are we to have all employees that will be working with the City have background checks prior to us submitting the proposal response and, therefore, we have to complete page 67 with "Passed" or "Failed" confirmed?

Actual background checks are only needed if your firm is recommended for award; however the Background Check Affidavit is required to be completed at the time of the submission.

7. Are we to do anything with pages 82 – 84 (Exhibits A, B and C)?

Please delete pages 82-84 (Exhibits A, B and C) there were erroneously included.
