#### The following are amendments to the RFP #355-19 REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL SERVICES:

1. A bid bond in the amount of \$15,000.00 must accompany the RFP response. Both payment and performance bonds of \$100,000.00 will be part of the awarded contract. Please complete and submit the attached bid bond for this project. The payment and performance bonds are not required until the contract is awarded.
2. All dates, terms and scope of services remain the same as posted in the IFB document.

#### The following are questions and answers to RFP #355-19 REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR DEBRIS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL SERVICES:

**QUESTION:** Can I get a bid tabulation / current contract pricing for debris removal and disposal services?

**ANSWER:** Yes, please find Ceres and Crowder Gulf's current contract pricing attached.

**QUESTION:** Please explain specifically how the pricing of one proposal will be evaluated against the pricing from another proposal, including the answer to these questions:

- a. Will each pricing proposal be analyzed and refined to become one total number which can then be compared to the other proposals, and if so, what is the formula that will be used to derive that total number?
- b. Will extended totals (unit price multiplied by estimated quantity) be used to evaluate pricing, and if so, what estimated quantities and what line items will be used to derive the extended totals that will be evaluated?
- c. Will all pricing line items be evaluated equally or will some line items receive more importance in the evaluation?

**ANSWER:** Each line item will be evaluated as one unit measure and totaled. The formula is as follows: A high/low variance will be calculated between the lowest response and each of the other responses for an individual difference in cost. The lowest total cost will be divided by 10 for to calculate the value of 1 point. The high/low variance calculated for each responder will then be divided by the value of 1 point to determine the grade reduction. The grade reduction

will then be deducted from 10 points (max to receive as in from 1 – 10). The points accumulated with then be multiplied by the weight of the cost.

**QUESTION:** Will the payment for Hazardous Trees and Limbs be for the cut only and placement of debris safely onto the ROW for collection?

**ANSWER:** As per the scope beginning on page 15, the contractor is to remove from the ROW, separate and move to the load sites.

**QUESTION:** Will the payment for Hazardous Stumps include hauling?

**ANSWER:** As per the scope beginning on page 17, the contractor is to remove hazardous stumps to the staging and reduction site. The scope further states the contractor shall be responsible for removing to the landfill per Federal, State and local laws and regulations and be responsible for tipping fees.

**QUESTION:** We are wondering if we have to bid for all 6 Event types laid out on pages 13-14?

**ANSWER:** As explained on page 13, the Contractor shall be available for technical assistance for each of the events described on pages 13 and 14. Your company will be evaluated on its experience with all six event types and the approach to the scope of work for each as described beginning on page 25 of the RFP.
