That the Board approve and authorize the Interim County Administrator to sign the agreement between Escambia County, Florida and Roads, Inc. of NWF per the terms and conditions of PD 18-19.012, Innerarity Point Road Area Drainage Improvements in the amount of \$375,249.77.

BACKGROUND:

The Innerarity Point Road Drainage Improvement Project is located on the North Side of Innerarity Point Road and includes work in the Bob-O-link, Cruzat and Gorham Road R/W's. Project consists of upgrading the existing stormwater conveyance system and asphalt roadway to address area drainage issues.

The project is located in Commissioner District 2.

The legal advertisement for this "Invitation to Bid" was advertised in the Pensacola News Journal on December 3 and December 10, 2018. A non-mandatory pre-solicitation conference was held on December 12, 2018. Seven firms were represented at that meeting. Bids were received from six contractors on January 9, 2019. Roads, Inc. of NWF is the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder.
