See below questions:

- 1) Under General Condition it states: L. NON-COLLUSION CERTIFICATION: "Each bidder shall execute an affidavit of non-collusion." Will this form be provided by the county?
- 2) GDOT issued a Bulletin last September, which I have attached to this email. Will the county allow the use of Antistripping Additives instead of Hydrated Lime in the mixes?
- 3) Does the county require the use of MTV's or shuttle buggy for this project?
- 4) What are work hours for this project?
- 5) On the roads that require edge milling only and overlay, will the county adjust manholes and utilities to match the new elevation or will that be the responsibility of the contractor?
- 6) If the contractor is to raise utilities, can the contractor use industry standard metal risers to match elevations?
- 7) On page 3 it states: "1 original and 3 copies of the Request For Bid must be submitted", however, on page 10, Identification of Bid Envelopes it states: "The signed Bid should be returned in a separate envelope or package". Does this mean the county request that the contractor put the Bid Schedule only in a separate envelope, and provide 1 original and 3 copies in addition to that? Please advise.
- 8) Will the Bid results be publicly read out on April 4th?

See below answers:

1. Paragraph L is amended to delete "each bidder shall execute an affidavit of non-collusion".
2. Antistripping additive is acceptable.
3. No shuttle buggy required
4. No hour restrictions
5. County will adjust manholes to match elevations
6. Handle in house
7. 1 original and 3 copies can be submitted in one envelope, with the bid bond and bid schedule.
