- Some of the roads listed are difficult to find on a mapping program, could you either provide a map for each road and/or Begin / End points for each road so that we can find them?
- Can you provide an estimated breakdown, by road, for the patching? What is your best guess for patching tons on each road? This helps us to better understand the intent of the Bid Item Tons.
- Will the County perform all Shoulder Grading, Low Soft Shoulder Signage, Grassing etc work that may be required after the completion of the paving?
- You tell us that Leveling is As Needed. Is there any way you could provide anything at all that tells us better how you came up with your 2500 Tons? (Depth?, Location? Percentage of Road to be Leveled?) This helps us to better understand the intent of the Bid Item Tons.
- Will there be any work or lane closure restrictions, or can we work whenever we think is most productive?
- Will the County require the Contractor to use Post Mounted Advanced Warning Signs for this project or will Portable Advanced Warning Signs be adequate?
