The following changes and clarifications shall be made to the Bid Documents for the Smartwater Zone Meter Install project.

The Village has opted to remove two sites from this project. Sites M2-3 and M2-4 will no longer be included and will be performed in house due to a necessary water shut down of these legs under the railroad ROW. Please use the revised Schedule of Prices (attached)

- Q1) It is my understanding that the village will be supplying all of the required saddles for the project. Will a corporation stop be required for all of these taps we will be making and if so who will be supplying these?
- A1) Yes, the Village will be providing the saddles. No corporation stop is required as the saddle accepts a temporary knife insert to block off the flow of water when the tapping machine is removed. A brass fitting is provided to close the saddle and then the knife is removed.
- Q2) For the new valve vaults that we will be installing, what is the depth of the existing water main we will be constructing these vaults over? If it is unknown, can you provide a depth of main for us to base our bid off of? It is a substantially different operation to install a vault on a water main 6' deep versus 10' deep. (additional spoil, trench backfill, restoration, cost of vault, labor / equipment hours to perform work, etc...)
- A2) The three locations where vaults are to be added are between 6-8 feet in depth.
- Q3) It is my understanding that we are to figure disposal of all of spoil generated at a CCDD facility. Is this the case? If we need to handle spoil as non special waste or hazardous material, how will this be handled?
- A3) Yes, spoils should be properly disposed of. If, for whatever reason, hazardous materials are encountered, a change order can be discussed at that time.
