This addendum is being released to answer questions received to date.

The information and documents contained in this addendum are hereby incorporated in the invitation to bid. This addendum must be acknowledged where indicated on the bid form, or the bid may be declared non-responsive.

Questions and Answers

1. Where is the closest available freshwater location to the island? Assuming the awarded contractor will need a water source to water in the plantings.

There is an 4-6" artesian well on the southwest side of Earman Island. It is recommended that the Contractor test the water quality of the well prior to use to ensure that it is acceptable for use in irrigation, as the County has never used the well. Any damage to the well would need to be repaired at the Contractor's expense. Additionally, the City of Vero Beach has water available on Indian River Boulevard near the 17th Street Bridge, the availability and suitability of this source would need to be confirmed by the Contractor.

Where is the closest available docking for small barge 25' x 10' to the island for loading plants,

2. equipment, and personnel? Can a county park nearby serve as a docking location for contractor watercraft?

(1) The 45th Street dock is owned by the County, and is in proximity to the site. The depth of water and suitability for use would need to be confirmed by the Contractor. There is a dock there, but no boat ramp. (2) the City of Vero Beach McWilliams boat ramp is also in proximity to the site; although this is a public launch, we would recommend that the Contractor coordinate with the City to make sure it is acceptable to use for loading materials. (3) there is a small dock/launch at the Wabasso Causeway Park.

The County could authorize a temporary permit to use the 45th Street dock, however, the security of anything docked at that location would be the responsibility of the Contractor.
