This addendum is being issued answer questions received on this solicitation. Questions and Answers

- Q1 To bid on projects that require a license. I don't personally have any but I work with a CGC. Do they have to be the ones bidding on the project or can my company bid on them as long as I have an agreement with them to utilize their license?
- A1 The awarded Vendor must hold a valid license that will enable them to obtain all necessary permits.
- Q2 I'm interested in bidding on this project. I do not have a CGC or demo license. I'm registered and have all the insurance.I have a working relationship with a CGC, who can obtain the proper permitting. Will that be an issue, If I'm working under their License?

- Q3 How can I locate recent demo projects that y'all have completed?
- A3 To review past solicitations and their awards, log into Vendor Registry and go to the "Expired" tab. There are past FWQ's listed that can be viewed for reference. The period of time may also be adjusted to locate additional solicitations.
- Q4 Is there someone i can contact about licensing requirements to find out sooner?
- A4 During the solicitation process to maintain a fair and completive process it is mandatory to provide everyone the same information. This process is done by formal written submission of questions, prior to the question deadline, the issuance of an addendum posted on VendorRegistry.com (there is a link from the County's web page.) The current question deadline is Monday, September 25, 2023, prior to 4:00 PM, the bid submissions are due seven days later on Monday, October 2, 2023.
