Plan Reference #60 Item 625 Description should read:

**“NO. 6 AWG 600 VOLT DISTRIBUTION CABLE, AS PER PLAN”**

(Both references erroneously called for 2400 Volt.)

*Item 2:*

Plan Reference #69 Plan note on page 16 of 31 *Clarification:*

A test shall be a hole that encounters any sub-surface condition that requires relocation of the proposed foundation. We will pay for the hole at the failed location if it is excavated. We will not pay for the hole under this item if the foundation hole is used.

*Item 3:*

Plan References #65, 99, and 100 Plan notes on page 16 of 31 and 21 of 31 *Clarification:*

These three Items refer to three different things. Reference #65 provides Power Service to the Millbank including all incidentals. This Millbank shall have a circuit breaker for the lighting separate circuit breaker to feed the Traffic Controller that will be installed in the column. Reference #99 & #100 is for the Power Service for the Traffic Controller that will be installed in the column.
