This addendum is being issued to revise the Bid form and provide answers to questions from the non- mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting held on January 23, 2018.

1. The revised Bid Form is attached and all Bidders must use this form when submitting a bid on this project.

Questions and Answers

1. Are there two public entrances to the Library?

Answer: Yes, there are two entrances. One is the main public Library entrance and the other could be used for access to the main library on a temporary basis.

Contractors should be aware of the Library hours. The Library is closed on Sunday and Monday, on Tuesday it is open 10:30 am-6:30 pm, and Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday the open hours are from 9:30 am - 5:30 pm.

2. Explain the quantity of 3 square yards for 6" thick concrete curbing?

Answer: The proposed 6" thick concrete curbs are considered incidental to the construction of the sidewalk, per FDOT Section 522. Please disregard Item #16 on Sheet No. 3 of the plan set and on the Bid Form. Please include any incidental work for the curb into the unit price for the concrete sidewalk. Please see the revised BID Form (Section 00300).

3. Task #6 Clearing & Grubbing: States includes tree removal but no tree removal is shown on plans. Please clarify if there is any three [tree] removal.

Answer: There are no trees to be removed with this project.
