



**Addendum 001**

**RFP 23-R0023**  
**Stage Trailer**

The purpose of this Addendum 001 to RFP 23-R0023 for a Stage Trailer dated April 27, 2023 is to provide clarification to comments/questions received.

1. How long is the side awning?

The side awning should be retractable and attached to the long side of the trailer around the opening for the stage. The awning would be of standard length and width to cover the majority of the stage when in use.

2. Is the awning a regular roll out camper style cloth awning?

The awning would be a retractable awning that would roll out. The awning would be made of standard material.

3. What would be the color and pattern of the awning?

The awning would be made of the standard material. The City of Myrtle Beach prefers solid white for all exterior colors. If white is not a standard color for the awning, provide pricing for standard colors and the City of Myrtle Beach will determine color at a later date.

4. Will there be a logo on the awning?

No, there will be no logo needed on the awning.

5. Is this a performance stage? If so, what is the required weight limit?

Yes, the stage may be used as a performance stage. The weight limit is 150 pounds per square foot.

6. What is the requested stage width?

The actual stage width may depend on the stage length. The stage should be a minimum of ten (10) feet wide.

7. Is the trailer style required to be a Soft V-Nose?

No, the trailer style does not have to be a Soft V-Nose. The trailer must have a V-Nose. A Round V-Nose or a Wedge V-Nose is acceptable.
