ITB No. 18-006 dated March, 2018 is hereby amended as noted herein : BIDDER TO ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT OF ADDENDUM BY SIGNING ON THE SIGNATURE LINE BELOW AND INCLUDING A COPY WITH SUBMITTED BID. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY, AT THE OWNER'S DISCRETION, SUBJECT THE BIDDER TO DISQUALIFICATION

- <u>QUESTION:</u> Item 4a Please explain what is wanted for this item? Do you mean directional bore? <u>ANSWER:</u> The length of the remaining water main is shown as varying as the directional bore will be longer than the corresponding jack and bore. The changes made to this line item are due solely to changes stemming from item #3 in this addendum.
- <u>QUESTION</u>: The location of the Overhead Power appears to be incorrectly shown on plan sheets 3, 4 & 5. Could you please confirm the actual location of the OHP?
 <u>ANSWER</u>: The overhead power location has been shown correctly on sheets 3 and 4, included in this addendum.
- 3) <u>QUESTION</u>: Bid Items 10 & 11 coordinate with natural gas company and underground telephone conflicts. Measurement and payment states that this item shall cover the cost of relocating the existing telephone and gas utilities as required. As we have no way to determine the extent of the conflicts or the cost of relocations, would you consider changing this to a county determined allowance for use and to cover the cost of any required relocations. Final payment would be for actual cost of relocations plus overhead and profit.

ANSWER: Potential gas conflicts consist of two perpendicular crossings for the proposed water main with existing gas service laterals. In lieu of relocating the gas main, the contractor shall route the water main underneath the gas service laterals using a vertical offset consisting of (four) 45 degree restrained joint bends with (three) joints of restrained pipe upstream of the vertical offset and (three) joints of restrained pipe downstream of the vertical offset. A pay item has been added and the revised bid form is included in this addendum. Measurement will be for each vertical offset. Payment will include labor and materials including the four restrained bends. The restrained joint pipe will be paid for in item 5 (under section III) restrained joint pipe. Pay item #10, "coordinate with natural gas company", will include scheduling with the City of Claxton to be on site when their lines are being crossed. Contractor shall provide at least 1' of separation between the gas service lateral and water main. Regarding telephone conflicts, if the conflict is a perpendicular crossing, the contractor shall provide one foot of separation using vertical offsets if required. If the telephone line is parallel for a potential conflict, then the telephone company must move the line. The contractor will not be responsible for moving the line or paying to move the line. A detail for perpendicular crossing has been included on Sheet 3.

- 4) <u>QUESTION:</u> Continuing with bid items 10 & 11. Has the county contacted the respective utility owners regarding relocations or received an estimated cost of the same? <u>ANSWER:</u> The County's representative engineering firm, Parker Engineering, has contacted the respective utility owners and provided them with construction drawings. Neither owner has provided a cost estimate for potential relocations; however as per item #3, this becomes a moot point to the contractor.
- 5) <u>QUESTION:</u> The plans show a detail for the replacement of asphalt driveways but there is not a detail for the replacement of concrete drives. Could you please provide a concrete driveway detail? <u>ANSWER:</u> A driveway detail has been provided on sheet 14, included in this addendum.
