**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE NEGOTIATED PRICE FOR A
GROUND PENETRATING RADAR SYSTEM FOR THE
UTILITIES DEPARTMENT FROM
POWER-TEL UTILITY PRODUCTS, INC.
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,545**


FINDINGS:

1. The bid opening for a Ground Penetrating Radar System for the Utilities Department was scheduled for March 10, 2022. No bids were received.
2. In accordance with Section 39-2-6(b) of the Code of Alabama, 1975, if no bids or only one bid is received, the City may negotiate for the work without advertising for bids a second time.
3. Because no bids were received, the City of Orange Beach accepts the negotiated price of \$18,545 for a Ground Penetrating Radar System, as specified by the bid documents, submitted by Power-Tel Utility Products, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE BEACH, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Orange Beach hereby accepts the negotiated price for a Ground Penetrating Radar System, as specified by the bid documents, submitted by Power-Tel Utility Products, Inc.;
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to approve payment to Power-Tel Utility Products, Inc., in the amount of \$18,545.00 for a Ground Penetrating Radar System; and
3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
