Skate Park Construction

The following questions have been asked and answered:

- 1. What are the amenities the City is looking for on this project?
 - A. The desired features of the skatepark are:
 - a. Quarter pipe with a raised platform
 - b. 3 other quarter pipes of various lengths and heights
 - c. 2 standard handrails
 - d. A-frame handrail
 - e. Long round rail
 - f. Handicap ramp
 - g. Slant bank
 - h. 4 stairs
 - i. 2 double-sided up and down Hubbas
 - j. Hip with Big Ledge
 - k. Flat bottom surface
- 2. In section 7.02, will a safety data sheet (SDS) be requested in our proposal? If so, where can we acquire a copy of this form?
 - A. This would only be required if you are using anything where contact might require medical attention. You can get the sheets online from the manufacturer.
- 3. In section 12 it states that the work in the contract shall be commenced in one day following the Notice to Proceed. Is that flexible at all? Is the formal contract the offerers responsibility, or will the City produce the contract?
 - A. It is our policy that the work commence the following day from the Notice to Proceed. The City will send the contract to the successful contractor.
- 4. "The contractor is responsible for all licenses, registrations, certifications and permits required." Could we see a list of these requirements?
 - A. We do not have a specific list. Each contract is different. The contractor is responsible for whatever license is required for their specific trade. You would also be responsible for obtaining a City Business License and Certificate of Insurance.
- 5. Since we are working from an existing foundation without new ground disturbances, will

construction documents be required? If so, will a state certified engineer or architect be required to approve these documents?

A. You will be required to show documentation to show any concrete structure you erect has the correct psi required for that structure. The contractor who designs the skatepark will have to show these documents.

The proposal opening date will remain the same, 2:00 May 4, 2018.
