- Does the system need to monitor the status of the doors?
 Answer: Inside doors do not need to be monitored. Outside doors do need to be monitored.
- 2. Does this system need to integrate with the active directory?

Answer: No

- 3. Will the system use the same cards?

 Answer: Vendors are to propose the most cost-efficient solution possible.
- 4. Different systems have different controllers, for example one controller may control 4 doors and another controller may control 8 doors. Which is preferred?

 Answer: Vendors are to propose the most cost-efficient solution possible.
- Where will the system be managed?
 Answer: Currently it is managed by Human Resources and Risk Management, but it may transition it to the Sheriff's Department.
- 6. Do you need a new badge printing system? Answer: No.
- 7. Does the County intend to award all to one vendor? Answer: Yes.
- 8. Are the elevators at the Jolley Building and Courthouse to be controlled by the system and schedule?

Answer: Yes, the elevators at the Jolley Building and Courthouse are to be controlled by the system and schedules set via the system.

Answer: No At the pre-bid meeting in the HR office your IT spokesperson stated that the system must be capable of this integration. To integrate with the existing Geovision camera system. Can you provide clarification on this? In this case, integration would mean associating a card reader with a nearby camera. To verify who actually used a card to open a door.
