This addendum becomes a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original specifications as noted.

Question Submitted to the Office of the Purchasing Agent

Q1. Regarding Paragraph 7.5.3: Does the pants knee design need have a “pouch” to accept extra layers of foam after the garment has been manufactured, or should there just be the ability to be able to order new garments with individual’s choice on the number of layers of foam?

A1. The City only requires the ability to put the appropriate padding in during manufacture.

Q2. Is the Delivery requirement 45 or 90 days? The first paragraph of section 4.15 says 90, but the “A.” paragraph says 45 days.

A2. Paragraph 4.5 (A) is changed to read:

"A. If the contractor does not completely fulfill the delivery of ordered garments (meeting the specifications detailed in the Invitation to Bid, awarded by Purchase Order, and ready for use by the City upon delivery) on or before the delivery date as specified (90 calendar days from date of issuance of Purchase Order), the contractor shall pay to the City, as fixed and agreed liquidated damages, for each calendar day between the date specified and the date of the certification of the completed delivery, an amount of **\$100.00 per day.**"

Q3. For the wear test samples, per Paragraph 7.4.23 Coat Closure System, which should be used, Option #1 or Option #2?

A3. The large coat shall have the Option #1 closure and the small coat shall have the Option #2 closure.
