RETURN OF GOODS: All merchandise is subject to a minimum restocking fee of 25%, plus freight, providing the manufacture will authorize the return of the merchandise. In some cases, the restocking fee will be more than 25%, depending upon the manufacturer. If a manufacture will not authorize the return of the merchandise, then Direct South will not be able to accept the return of the merchandise.

FREIGHT DAMAGE: <u>Per new 'NMFC' National Motor Freight Class guidelines</u>, <u>effective April 18, 2015, concealed damages must be reported to carriers</u> within 5 days after delivery.

Currently, <u>concealed damages</u> can be reported up to 15 days after delivery for consideration of a valid claim, but per NMFC guidelines effective April 18, 2015, the time period for reporting concealed damages is being reduced 5 days. I have attached a document with all changes being implemented by the NMFC effective April 18, and below is a summation of the concealed damage rule change.

Please be aware that this is not a ReTrans policy/rule, rather a change being enacted by the NMFC. Please make sure that you are instructing ALL your customers to inspect their freight when it is delivered. They should be making note of any damages on the Bill of Lading when the delivery is made and notify Boelter so that a claim can be processed right away. Any supporting document helps with claims – i.e. pictures of the damaged freight. It is also very important to keep any packaging. This will assist if an inspection is required.

Supplement 1 to NMF 100-AO, effective April 18, 2015 ITEM 300135-A REPORTING CONCEALED DAMAGE

(a) When damage to, or loss of, contents of a shipping container is discovered by the consignee that could not have been determined at time of delivery it must be reported by the consignee to the delivering carrier upon discovery. (b) Reports must include a request for inspection by the carrier's representative. (c) Notice of loss or damage and request for inspection may be given by telephone or in person, but in either event must be confirmed by sa written or electronic communication. s (d) While awaiting inspection by carrier, the consignee must hold the shipping container and its contents in the same condition they were in when damage was discovered, insofar as it is possible to do so, s (e) Unless otherwise specified by the carrier, notice of loss or damage should be provided to the carrier within five (5) business days from the date of **delivery.** s (f) If five (5) business days, or such other period as specified by the carrier, pass between the date of delivery of the shipment by carrier and date of report of loss or damage and request for inspection by consignee, it is incumbent upon the consignee to offer reasonable evidence to the carrier's representative when inspection is made that loss or damage was not incurred by the consignee after delivery of shipment by carrier.
