SPECIFICATIONS FOR TWO (2) SCUM SKIMMERS FOR MOCCASIN BEND DIVISION OF WASTE RESOURCES CHATTANOOGA TENNESSEE July, 2017

GENERAL INFORMATION

This specification is for the purchase of 2 scum skimmers for Chlorine contact tanks 1 and 2. The skimmers will be used at open tanks of wastewater in the Moccasin Bend Wastewater Treatment Plant. The City or its contractor will install the equipment. Price is to include startup.

Components made in Iran are not allowed.

The plant is located at 455 Moccasin Bend Road, Chattanooga, Tn. 37405.

PART 1 - DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

The two units shall be 8" diameter x 11'-8" long each with a manual handwheel operator designed to skim material off of the top of settled water channels.

Each unit shall be equivalent to an Amwell Model "PSG" scum skimmer mechanism

<u>Pipe</u> - One (1) 8" diameter Sch. 20 (0.25" wall) steel pipe with 60° wide slot as measured on the chord of the arc. Slot shall be cut symmetrically about the vertical axis of the pipe and the edged shall be parallel to the longitudinal axis of the pipe.

At regular intervals of not more than 2'-6" a 2" wide band of the full pipe periphery shall be left in the pipe to act as a stiffener.

<u>Wall Bearings (Brackets)</u> - One (1) full circle rolled steel collar welded to an adjustable steel plate shall be provided at each end of trough for support.

Wall bearing shall be provided with a rolled UHMW-PE bearing bar attached to the internal periphery to provide ample bearing surface for the pipe without crushing the seal and to improve ease of rotation.

The wall bearing design shall allow a slight vertical or horizontal misalignment without interfering with the smooth operation of the pipe.

Neoprene Fillers - One (1) 1/4" thick neoprene fillers shall be supplied for use as required between bearing and wall to make a watertight connection at both ends without grouting either end.

<u>Seal</u> - 1" wide "D" shaped black Buna-N ring seal. The seal shall not be affected by grease, mild acids or alkalis and must be readily removable without removing the pipe from the wall bearing support.

The seal shall be constructed so that it remains effective even with a slight misalignment of pipe and wall bearing and shall not impede the smooth action of the revolving pipe.

Pipe Clamp Collar/Ret - Two (2) fabricated steel clamping type collars with 304 stainless steel hardware shall be provided. Collars lock pipe into position between wall bearings and retain seal within the wall bearing assemblies.

Mechanical Gear Operating Mechanism - One (1) gear operated mechanism capable of rotating the scum pipe 180 degrees in either direction. Mechanism shall consist of the following components:

One (1) 18" diameter cast iron handwheel keyed to top of shaft extension.

One (1) 1 1/2" Schedule 40 steel pipe shaft extension connecting handwheel to worm drive shaft.

One (1) 1 1/2" dia. steel drive shaft keyseated as required through worm and bolted to shaft extension pipe.

One (1) fabricated steel shaft guide bracket.

One (1) 4" P.D. x 4" long cut steel 3 pitch, R.H. single thread, 14 1/2° pressure angle, worm bored, and keyseated for 1 1/2" diameter shaft.

One (1) 18" P.D. 48 tooth, 3 pitch, R.H. single thread, 14 1/2° pressure angle, cast iron, cut tooth worm gear bored, drilled and tapped for mounting on skimmer pipe.

Two (2) rigid, babbitt lined grease lubricated pillow block bearings for supporting 1 1/2" diameter worm shaft.

End Wall Bracket - A full circle rolled steel collar welded to an adjustable steel plate shall be provided at the opposite end of trough for support.

Wall bearing shall be provided with a rolled UHMW-PE bearing bar attached to the internal periphery to provide ample bearing surface for the pipe without crushing the seal and to improve ease of rotation.

Anchor Bolts - One (1) lot of 304 stainless steel Simpson Strong-Tie Wedge-All anchors shall be provided for each skimmer.

<u>Painting</u> - All surfaces (except galvanized, stainless steel, gear faces or shafts) shall be sandblasted to SSPC-SP10 specifications followed by one (1) shop coat of Tnemec Series N69-1211 Hi-Build Epoxoline II red primer with a dry film thickness of 3.0 to 5.0 mils.

Face of gear and shaft to be coated with rust inhibitive.

Pillow block bearings to have standard finish coats of manufacturer.

Fasteners - All fasteners to conform to A.I.S.I. 304 stainless steel.

SHIPPING AND DELIVERY

Vendor shall state delivery time in his bid and shall include all shipping costs. The rings shall be delivered to Moccasin Bend Wastewater Treatment Plant, 455 Moccasin Bend Road, Chattanooga Tennessee 37405.

WARRANTY

The manufacturer of the equipment shall warranty for one (1) year from date of purchase that the equipment will be free from defects in design, material and workmanship.
