

Sealed Bids: The Jones County Board of Commissioners will accept sealed bids for the construction of the project entitled **Stand-By Power for the Jones County Government Center, The EMA Office, The 911 Tower and The Haddock Wells**. Bids will be opened on June 11, 2021 at 3:00 p.m. local prevailing time at the **Jones County Government Center at 166 Industrial Blvd., Gray, Georgia 31032**. All Bids will be publicly opened and read. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) calendar days.

Contractor License: Any Contractor submitting a bid must be licensed by the State of Georgia and be fully insured and bonded. License numbers must be written on the face of the bid envelope. No bid will be opened unless it contains the Contractor's license number. See Instructions to Bidders for additional bidding requirements.

Work to Be Done: The work to be done shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to construct the project titled **Stand-By Power for the Jones County Government Center, The EMA Office, The 911 Tower and The Haddock Wells** as shown on the construction drawings. In general, construction consists of the following:

- Jones County Government Center: Furnish and install an automatic transfer switch and all necessary conduits, wiring, connections, coordination with Tri-County EMC and any miscellaneous appurtenances for a complete and operational project. For this site, the generator is installed onsite. All of the conduits from the junction box to the transfer switch and the conduits from the generator to the transfer switch are installed as well as the generator pad. Start-up of the generator and transfer switch is part of this contract.
- The EMA Office and The 911 Tower: The contractor shall remove the existing generators and deliver both generators to Jones County. The Contractor shall then furnish and install a new generator for each site. Start-up is included for each site.
- Haddock Wells: The contractor shall furnish and install a new generator for each well site. In general, construction consists of furnishing and installing a new generator, concrete generator pad, all conduit, all wiring, automatic transfer switches, internal wiring upgrades and any miscellaneous appurtenances for a complete project.

The contractor may bid one (1) installation, two (2) installations or all three (3) contracts.

Plans and Contract Documents: Plans and Contract Documents are on file for review at the Jones County BOC and at the Dodge Plan Room. 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Bonds: All bid forms must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid. The successful bidder, if awarded the Contract, will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount. All bonds must appear on the Treasury Department's most current Circular 570 Listing, latest edition.

Funding: Any Contract or Contracts awarded under this Advertisement for Bids are subject to Jones County Purchasing guidelines and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA – The EMA Office and The 911 Tower). All other funds will be local funds.
