Purpose of Request for Quote

The City of White House is soliciting quotes from qualified artists interested in painting murals for the new public library located at 105-B College Street, White House, TN 37188. Please place a separate price quote for each room (Teen and Children) from the total base quote. The dimensions of each room are will be sent with this request.

- Teen room
 - Current library builders are going to paint an area about 24' wide by 6' tall with chalk board paint. A creative boarder will need to be painted around the chalk board paint area.
- Children's story time room
 - Ocurtains will need to be painted around the stage which is an area of $9' \frac{1}{2}$ by 17-17/8.
 - Story book characters will need to be painted on both walls on either side of the stage area. Size will depend on size of book character and the number of characters.

Scope of Services

The selected firm will be required to provide services including, but not limited to, the following:

- Painting *including* creating original drawings for each mural
- Staffing
- Supplies
- Equipment
- Keeping site work clean

Awarded Proposal Requirements

- 1. Timeline of work to be completed
- 2. Must submit at least three (3) references on similar projects
- 3. Must submit pictures of similar projects
- 4. Must have a business license with the City of White House
- 5. Must have experience in managing comparably sized operations
- 6. Any equipment that is essential to the company's operation must be provided by the company.

RFQ Evaluations

RFQ will be evaluated based on the following criteria (not listed in any order of importance):

- 1. Proposer's proven ability with similar projects.
- 2. Proposer's capacity to perform.
- 3. History and years of experience of the proposer.
- 4. References
- 5. Creativeness/Originality
- 6. Timeliness

Proposals Opening

Proposals shall be opened in a manner that avoids disclosure of contents to competing Proposers. Sealed quotes will be opened during the first evaluation committee meeting.

Final Ranking and Selection

A committee will make a recommendation that is the most advantageous to the City, considering the evaluation factors set forth in the RFQ. Recommended contract awarded, if any, resulting from this RFQ is subject to the approval of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. In all cases, the City will be the sole judge as to whether a Proposer has or has not satisfactorily met the requirements of this RFQ. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any Proposal, to accept a Proposal containing variations from these specifications if the Proposal so merits.

Negotiations

The City retains the right to make an award based on initial proposals without negotiations.

Changes in the RFQ

Any communication from the City to a Proposer will be transmitted simultaneously to all Proposers along with written questions submitted. Any Proposer who fails to recognize or utilize this process of communication will be notified of its violation of the process and may be disqualified. All addenda will be numbered in sequence, dated as of the date of issue, and sent via email, fax, or mail to all Proposers.

Verbal Agreements

No verbal agreement or conversation with any officer, agent or employee of the City, either before or after execution of the Contract, shall affect or modify any of the terms or obligations contained in the Contract. Any such verbal agreement or conversation shall be considered unofficial information and in no way binding upon the City or the Contractor.

Reservation of Rights

The City reserves and holds at its discretion the following rights and options:

- a. Issue addenda to the Request For Quote, including extending or otherwise revising the timeline for submittals;
- b. Withdraw the Request for Quotes;
- c. Request clarification and/or additional information from the Proposer at any point in the procurement process;
- d. Execute a Contract with Proposer, on the sole basis of the original quote;
- e. Reject any or all Quotes, waive irregularities in any Quote, accept or reject all or any part of any Quote, waive any requirements of the Request, pick and choose Proposers to do sections of the RFQ depending on price, as may be deemed to be in the best interest of the City; and
- f. Reissue or modify the Request for Quotes.
- g. Reject any or all quotes if all quotes are over \$9,999.

In order to be considered for selection, responses must be received on or before the date and time specified. Firms mailing responses should allow normal mail delivery time to ensure timely receipt by the City. Proposals received after the stated time shall not be considered. No fax or email transmittals will be accepted.

Disposition of Quotes

All materials submitted in response to this Proposal will become the property of the City of White House. One (1) copy of each quote shall be retained for official files. It is understood that the proposal will become part of the official file on this matter without obligation on the part of the City of White House. All Quotes become the property of the City upon submission and will not be returned to the applicant.

Disclosure

Any trade secrets or proprietary information submitted by a vendor in connection with this procurement shall not be subject to public disclosure. However, the vendor must invoke the protection of this section prior to or upon submission of the data or other materials by identifying the specific area or scope of data or other materials to be protected and state the reasons protection is necessary. An all-inclusive statement that the entire proposal is proprietary is not acceptable. A statement that cost proposals are to be protected is not acceptable. There is no expressed or implied obligation for the City of White House to reimburse responding firms for any expenses incurred in preparing proposals in response to this request.
