### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Maplewood Richmond Heights School District is seeking bids for two out of state trips for approximately between 105-120 students plus approximately 20 chaperones.

MRH Middle School routes its work from the metaphor of school as expedition, taking students outside of the classroom over 15% of the school year. Student learning is taking place outside, in the community, or beyond the community. This approach to learning shifts the focus into the natural environment and promotes a connection with the community. An example would be students studying water quality and its relationship to macroinvertebrates starting in our local watershed in 7th grade and ending with a trip to Ocean Springs, MS and the Gulf of Mexico at the end of 8th grade. MRHMS was the focus of a viral video (<a href="https://goo.gl/GOlH0E">https://goo.gl/GOlH0E</a>) when our school produced a video around biodiversity and salamanders in the Smoky Mountains. Expeditionary learning creates a space for students to begin to view the world through a lens of justice and fairness, and then explore the causation for the social, economic, and environmental justice issues that surround us every day. This is the heart of Education for Sustainability, and it has been at the center of the work at MRH Middle School for a decade.
