The City of Springfield, Tennessee, will be accepting sealed bids from companies that want to provide the city with trash removal services for the Springfield Water and Wastewater Department. Potential bidders can either pick up bid specifications at the Springfield Water and Wastewater Department (SWWD) office at 924 Central Avenue or can call the SWWD office at 615-382-1600 to have bid specifications mailed or e-mailed out. Sealed bids must be received at the Office of the Springfield City Recorder, at 405 N. Main Street, Springfield, Tennessee, 37172 Attention: Ms. Lisa Crockett, City Recorder, on or before 2:00 p.m. local time on Monday, April 13, 2015, at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Any bid envelopes received after 2:00 p.m. on April 13, 2015, will be rejected. **The outside of the sealed envelope shall include the BID NUMBER 933 and that the sealed envelope contains a bid for TRASH REMOVAL SERVICES FOR THE SPRINGFIELD WATER AND WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT.**

The successful bidder will provide trash receptacles (dumpsters), which are to be located in the following three sites:

Two (2) 6-yard slant dumpsters, emptied one (1) time every two weeks

The SWWD anticipates taking the proposed contract with the low bidder to the regularly-scheduled April 21, 2015, meeting of the Springfield Board of Mayor and Aldermen. If approved by the board, the contract is anticipated to go into effect on May 1, 2015. The bid price is to include all regulatory and environmental charges. The City of Springfield reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
