

QUALIFICATIONS TO BE OPENED: January 16, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. (Eastern Time)

This addendum is being published to revise the “Project Details & Background Information” section of the RFQ as it pertains to the name of the Cradle of Country Music Park. This addendum becomes a part of the contract documents and modifies the original specifications as noted below.

The first paragraph of the “Project Details and Background Information” section of the RFQ is changed to read as follows with the new revised language in italicized font

The designated location for the commissioned work or works of art is the city park located at the corner of Summit Hill Drive and Gay Street in downtown Knoxville. The park, currently known as the Cradle of Country Music Park, is slated for redesign; design teams participating in a design charrette developed six distinctive park concept plans which can be reviewed at <http://knoxvillepublicart.com/downtown-park/>. In 1986 the Cradle of Country Music Park was developed to recognize Knoxville’s role in the birth of Country Music and is included on the east Tennessee Historical Society’s self-guided walking tour. *At this juncture, prospective qualifiers should not feel that the work of art must have something to do with Country Music. At present, the City is only working to determine (via this RFQ) who the most qualified artists are so that we can send those artists a subsequent Request for Proposals (RFP) for the actual art work.*

The redesigned, re-named park will provide desperately needed space for outdoor performances and recreation, and will serve as a gathering place and point of civic pride. The work of art and redesigned park should also serve as a connector between Market Square, the old City, and the 300 Block of Gay Street across Summit Hill to the 100 Block of Gay Street. A map of the current park is provided, as Exhibit “A” with this RFQ.
