

ADDENDUM NO. 1
2023 GREENEVILLE RESURFACING PROGRAM BID

This addendum shall become a part of the project plans and specifications and shall be included in the bid proposal.

Addendum Date: 5/5/2023

1. Paragraph 3 of Section A states:

“Bidders shall place their bid in a sealed envelope along with a bid bond and certificates of insurance. The outside of the envelope must indicate the bidder's name, license number, expiration date, and that part of classification applying to the bid in accordance with TCA 62-6-119. Bids not conforming to these provisions shall not be opened.”

This paragraph shall be replaced in its entirety with the following:

“Bidders shall place their bid in a sealed envelope along with a bid bond and certificates of insurance. The outside of the envelope must indicate the bidder's name, license number, expiration date, and that part of classification applying to the bid in accordance with TCA 62-6-119. Bids not conforming to these provisions shall not be opened. Each proposal must be accompanied by a bidder's bond, Cashier's Check, or Certified Check made payable to the TOWN in an amount equaling not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid. In the case of alternate items in the proposals, the amount of the bidder's bond or check must be in an amount equaling not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the base bid and alternates. If a check is offered as guaranty, the check of the successful bidder will be cashable at the discretion of the TOWN, pending the satisfactory execution and acceptance of the contract and the contract bond.”

2. Section C, Part 1.A. shall be replaced in its entirety with the following:

“The work described consists of furnishing all traffic control, vegetation matter removal, clearing, cleaning, tack coat, and any necessary incidental work required to install an asphalt overlay on the streets in the table listed below. The overlay shall be TDOT Item No. 411 Asphaltic Concrete Surface Mix (PG64-22) Grading D RDWY at a depth of 2.0-inches or TDOT Item No. 411 Asphaltic Concrete Surface Mix (PG64-22) Grading E RDWY at a depth of 2.0-inches, as specified in the table:”

3. Section C, Part 1B. shall be replaced in its entirety with the following:

“The work described consists of furnishing all traffic control, vegetation matter removal, clearing, cleaning, tack coat, and any necessary incidental work required to install an asphalt overlay on the streets in the table listed below. The overlay shall be TDOT Item No. 411 Asphaltic Concrete Surface Mix (PG64-22) Grading D RDWY at a depth of 2.0-inches or TDOT Item No. 411 Asphaltic Concrete Surface Mix (PG64-22) Grading E RDWY at a depth of 2.0-inches, as specified in the table:”

4. Section C, Part 11 shall be replaced in its entirety with the following:

11. Utilities & Patchwork

The Town of Greeneville shall be responsible for the adjustment of all caps, covers, and utility manholes affected by the project. The Town of Greeneville shall also be responsible for any patchwork required before the placement of the asphalt overlays specified in the project.

5. Part 13 shall be added to Section C:

13. Miscellaneous

The contractor shall not be responsible for the installation of any pavement markings except for those described in Section C Part 3. Also, the contractor shall not be responsible for the replacement of any traffic signal loop detectors or for cutting any saw slots.
