REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The City of Shelbyville is requesting proposals for **OUTDOOR WATERSLIDE TOWER MAINTENANCE/REPAIR located at Shelbyville Recreation Center, 220 Tulip Tree Road, Shelbyville, TN.**

Proposals will be accepted by the City of Shelbyville Purchasing Office, 201 N. Spring St., Shelbyville, TN 37160 or may be mailed to P.O. Box 185, Shelbyville, TN 37162 **until 3:00 P.M., January 26, 2017.** Proposals should be submitted in sealed envelopes marked "**OUTDOOR WATERSLIDE TOWER MAINTENANCE/REPAIR - Shelbyville Recreation Center**". Any proposals received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of proposals will be returned to the bidder unopened.

Proposals will be opened at public meeting of council appointed bid committee on Thursday, January 26, 2017 at 3:00 P.M. at City Hall, 201 N. Spring Street. Award of the proposal will be made at the next scheduled City Council Meeting (February 9, 2017) at the Shelbyville City Hall Annex.

MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS:

Scope: To repair and perform any maintenance needed to the outdoor waterslide stairway, tower and support steel at Shelbyville Recreation Center.

Work to be completed:

- Clean the rust, oxidation, and flaking paint from affected areas and recoat

- Replace stair treads and decking with Deck Lok decking systems or equal
 - New treads will be white or light grey in color (white preferred) and MUST fit into framing so that the tread is FLUSH with the framing and there is no possible trip hazard due to construction.
 - Treads must be 100% vinyl, tongue and groove system with no exposed fasteners and have a wood grain texture providing a non-slip surface that stays cool to the touch.
- Replace rusted hardware at column connections and where needed.
- Specify in proposal the exact areas of repair
- **SITE VISIT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**

Site information:

- Slide is an outdoor, 42" open flume
- Ride is 125' long with three turns
- Slide was installed by Professional Parks Inc (no longer existing) in 2003
- The flume portion of slide was repaired/maintained in 2016. This current proposal repair work is strictly stairway, tower and support steel.

- 1) Total price of proposal
- 2) Date(s) of estimated repair/maintenance
- 3) Any variations/additions to the above specifications
- 4) Warranty information

Successful bidder will coordinate dates of repair with Director Mike Alsup, 931-684-9780.

Successful bidder must provide proof of business license and liability insurance. Successful bidder must also provide proof of workers compensation insurance if required.

Please note any variations to these requirements on submitted proposal.

Vendor selection will be based upon the best offer deemed acceptable by the City of Shelbyville's council appointed bid committee and City Council. Proposal to all or part of the RFP indicates a willingness to supply part or all of the proposal. The City of Shelbyville reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.

All bidders must comply with A.D.A. guidelines if required.

All bidders must be in compliance with Title VI, Civil Rights Act of 1964, which specifies that: No person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under a program or activity receiving federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation or the U. S. Department of Justice.

Failure on the part of the bidder to comply with all instructions herein may result in bid rejection.

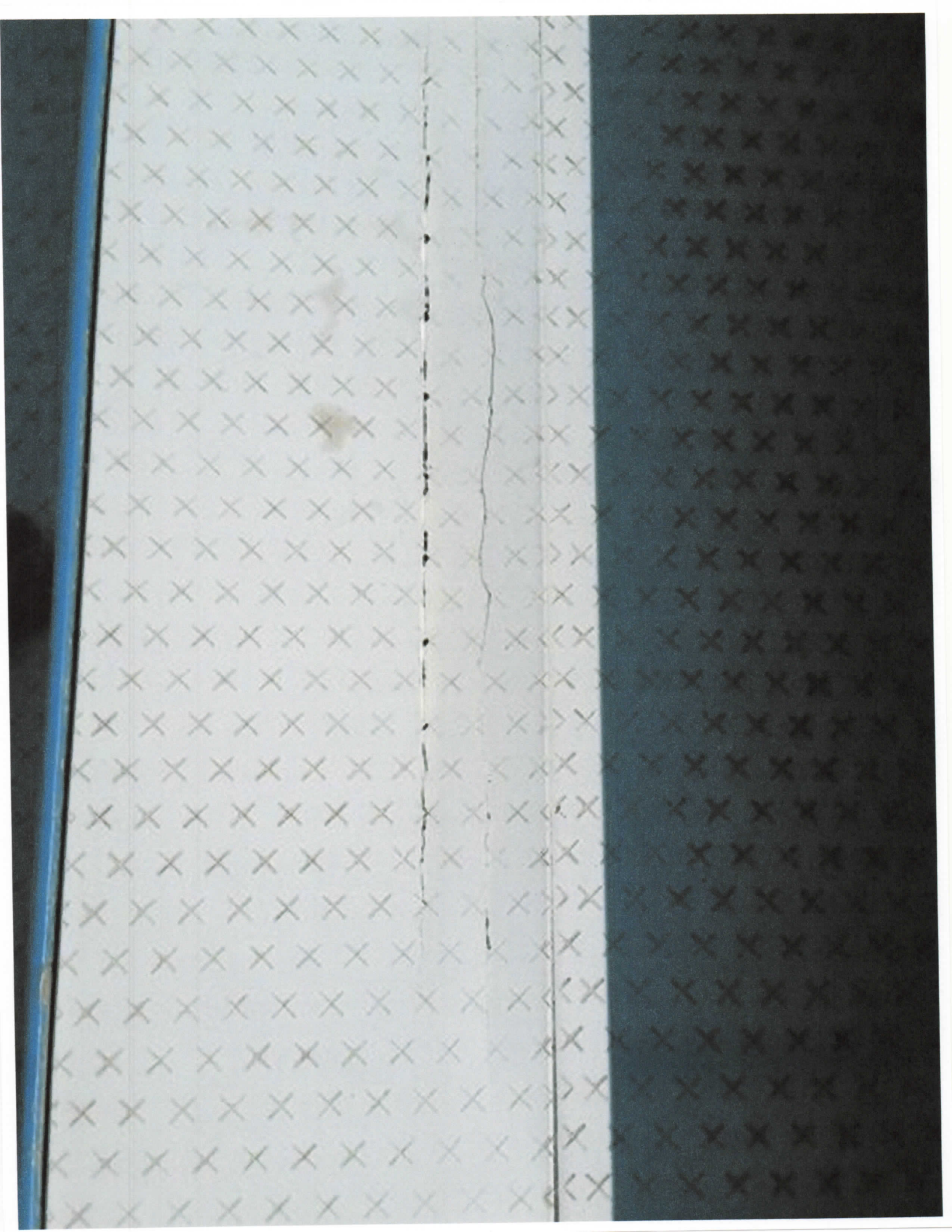

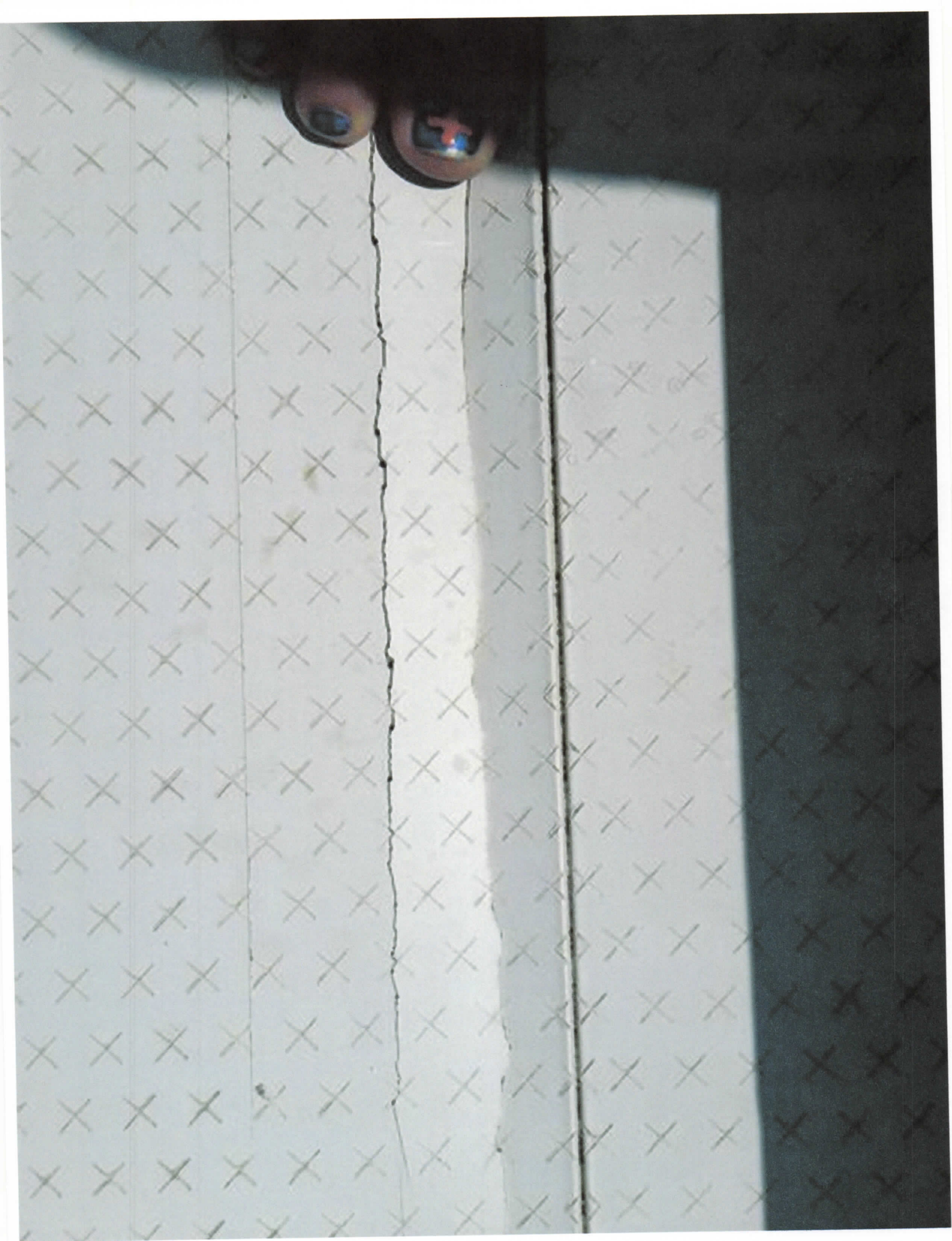

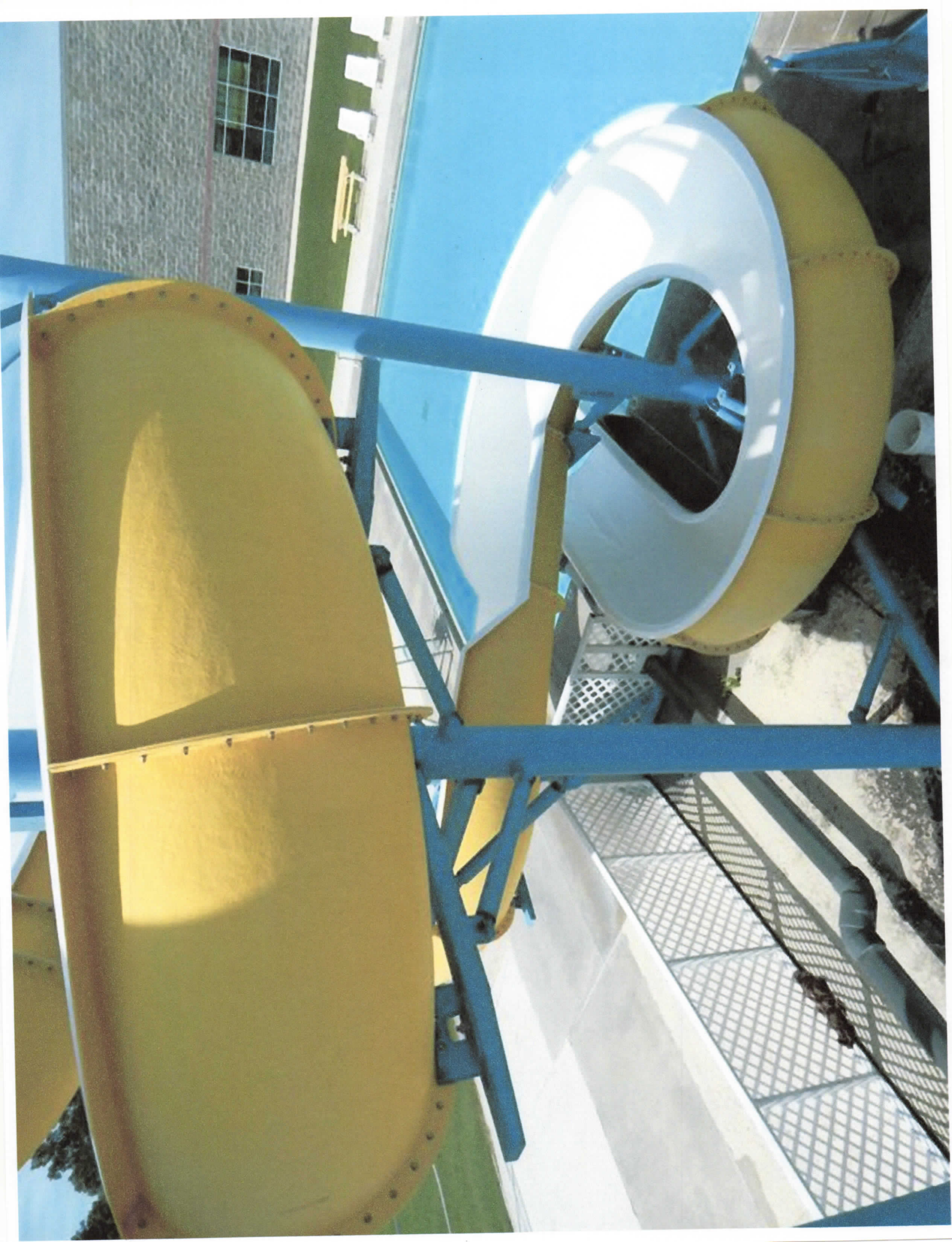






















OUTDOOR POOL RULES & REGULATIONS
