Questions and Answers

1.	Will the Multi Family unit that receives curbside carted service in the universal carted option be
	on the universal billing? If so where on the price proposal form will the vendor submit that rate?
	A: The County defines Multi-Family as five or more units. While these complexes may elect to utilize a cart as the collection container, they will typically be serviced as site service rather than
	curbside service for each individual unit. Proper sizing of containers shall be determined
	between Franchisee and Customer with the support of SWDD, where applicable. (See Article
	6.6.3 added to the Sample Agreement in Addendum 9.)
	Under Multi-Family Universal Service (Options #2 and #4) invoicing will occur monthly per unit rather than by container size (as priced for Multi-Family Subscription Service (Options #1 and #3)). (See Sample Agreement Article 6.6.5 established in Addendum 9).
	Proposers shall submit their monthly rate per unit for Multi-Family Universal Service (Options
	#2 and #4) on Addendum 9 Price Form sheet 2, under the section Multi-Family Universal Service
	(Options #2 and #4).
	Can the County confirm that for the Multi-Family unit that receives service more than one time
2.	per week, that the contractor can bill the additional service at the submitted commercial rates per yard.

A: Not confirmed.

For clarification, Multi-Family Subscription Service (Options #1 and #3) shall be priced by size and frequency as noted on Addendum 9 Price Form sheet 3 "Multi-Family Subscription Service," to include pricing for an extra scheduled pickup.

Multi-Family Universal Service (Options #2 and #4) solid waste collection shall be priced by a base rate of one time per week. Should a complex seek collection frequency greater than once per week, this would be considered a Supplemental Service and would be billed directly between Franchisee and "complex" Customer (See Addendum 9 Sample Agreement modifications Article 6.6.5) at the rate for an extra scheduled pickup per container size as identified on Addendum 9 Price Form sheet 3 "Multi-Family Subscription Service (Options #1 and #3)."
